Dear Michelle, ASAR Councillors and members,

Over recent months there has been a significant amount of discussion relating to the suggestion that a particular private education provider (PEP) is suing the ASAR.

Unfortunately, the unwillingness or inability of the ASAR to provide the actual name of this provider means that all providers of ultrasound education are potentially at risk of being assumed to be in dispute with the ASAR.

**I would like to make it clear that the private education provider (PEP) being referred to is NOT the Australian School of Medical Imaging (ASMI).**

ASMI has a strong history of delivering quality education for the last six years, all of which is accredited by the ASAR with our Graduate Program in Medical Ultrasound (GPMU) having articulation with the Grad Dip as provided by reputable universities including Monash, Uni SA, RMIT, Charles Sturt University and the DMU by ASUM.

Furthermore, ASMI has always been, and continues to be a strong supporter and advocate of the current education and qualification framework in place for the Sonography profession and qualification.

I would be grateful if you could pass this clarification on to your members to avoid any further confusion in this regard.
