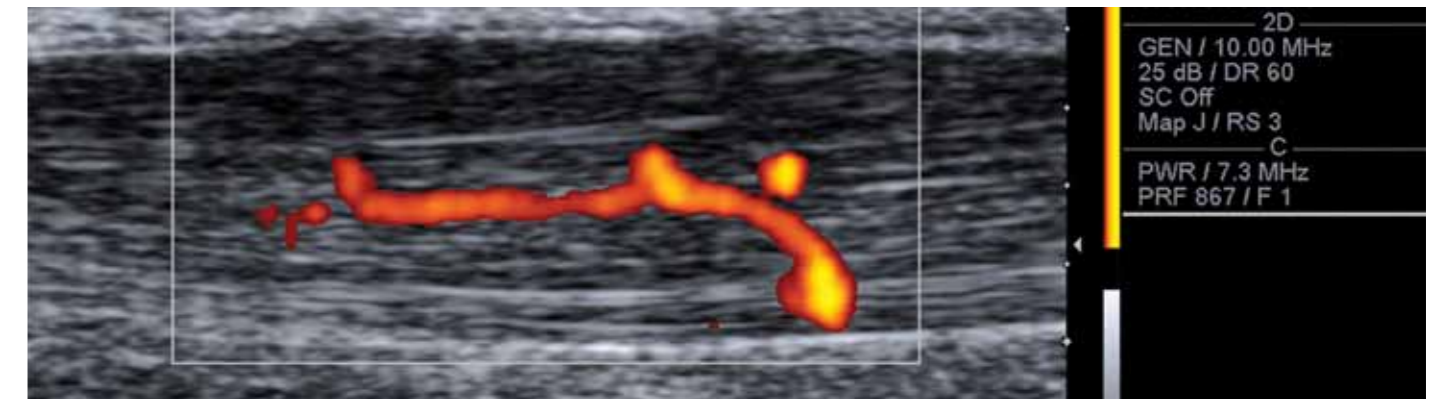

John completed his radiology training at Westmead Hospital, Sydney in 1985. He entered private practice in 1987 and rapidly acquired a special interest in high-resolution ultrasound. In 1993 he entered subspecialty imaging practice at the North Sydney Orthopaedic & Sports Medicine Centre.

This practice has progressively expanded over the past 14yrs to now encompass the full gamut of imaging modalities from plain x-ray to high-field MRI.
